

Brief details of options granted	Total number of Options to be granted under the Scheme shall not exceed 5% (Five percent) of the paid-up equity capital as on March 31, 2018 The ESOP Plan would be implemented through the Subex Employee Welfare and ESOP Benefit Trust ("ESOP Trust"), as it is proposed that the equity shares of the Company would be acquired from the secondary market
2.	Whether the scheme is in terms of SEBI (SBEB) Regulations, 2014	Yes
3.	Pricing Formula	Exercise price shall not be less than the average market price at which the equity shares of the Company are acquired by the Trust
4.	Brief details of significant terms	The vesting period shall be decided by the Compensation Committee from time to time but shall not be less than one year and more than four years from the grant of options
5.	Provision of loan to the ESOP Trust	The Company shall make such interest free loans from time to time, to fund the ESOP Trust which shall be utilized for the sole purpose of purchase of equity shares of the Company from the secondary market through the stock exchange mechanism. Such loans to the ESOP Trust, shall not exceed the limit of 2% (two percent) of the aggregate of paid-up share capital and free reserves of the Company
